God is the source of Agape love. 1 John 4:7-8

"Beloved, let us love one another for love is from God..." 1 John 4:7a

- **The beautiful meaning of the Greek word "agape."** 1 John 4:7a
Mentioned 320 times in the Bible. Agape is a Greek word for love. It means sacrificial, unconditional, servant-hearted love. Agape love says, "I love you" even when it is not convenient, deserved or reciprocated.
- **God is the originator, inventor and source of agape love.** 1 John 4:7b-8
Like a freshwater spring that gives life to a river, God is the spring and source of agape love.

God gives us the perfect demonstration of Agape love. 1 John 4:9-10

"By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent his only begotten Son into the world so that we might live."

1 John 4:9

- **God reveals the depth of His agape love for us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus.** 1 John 4:8
- **Jesus wasn't just making a sacrifice for our sins, He was the sacrifice (propitiation) for our sins.** 1 John 4:10

We are called to be ambassadors of God's Agape love. 1 John 4:11-21

"We love because He first loved us..." 1 John 4:19

- **Our visible love for one another reveals the invisible love of God.** 1 John 4:11-12
- **The triune God is present in our calling to love others.** 1 John 4:13-17
- **We can walk without fear as we live out our calling to love others.** 1 John 4:18-21

LifeGroup Discussion:

1. **Read 1 John 4:7-8.** When did you first experience the agape love of God? How old were you? What was the setting and circumstance? Do you have any daily distractions that block you from experiencing and knowing God's agape love?
2. **Read 1 John 4:9-10 four times aloud as a group.** Take some time after reading the passage to pray together and thank God for His agape love and for sending Jesus into our world to be the sacrifice for our sins.
3. **Read 1 John 4:11-21.** We are called to be ambassadors of God's agape love to those around us. Share practical ideas of how you can live out this calling to be ambassadors of God's agape love in your home, at work, in your neighborhood and even around the world. Commit to pray for one another and hold each other accountable to live out this calling.
