

Living Free through Difficult Love Romans 13:8-10

The Value of Love: It fulfills the law of God. Romans 13:8

"Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law"

Romans 5:5

The People to love: Our "neighbor" regardless of the circumstances. Romans 13:9-10 "For this, 'YOU SHALL NOT COMMIT ADULTERY, YOU SHALL NOT MURDER, YOU SHALL NOT STEAL, YOU SHALL NOT COVET,' and if there is any other commandment, it is summed up in this saying, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.' Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfillment of the law."

Four violations of love and how to overcome them:

- Adultery: Physical and emotional Matthew 5:27-28, Job 31:1, I Corinthians 6:16-20
- Murder: Physical and emotional Matthew 5:21-22, John 8:44, Ephesians 4:26-27
- **Stealing:** Two ways we can steal:
 - How employers steal James 5:4
 - O How employees steal Titus 2:9-10
 - O How Christians steal from God Acts 5:2-3, Malachi 3:8-10
- Coveting:

Exodus 20:17; James 4:1, 2; Romans 12:15-17; Philippians 4:11-13

How to love if you are the victim of these four violations: II Corinthians 2:6-8

Digging Deeper

- Murder: Matthew 5:21-22, John 8:44, Ephesians 4:26-27
- **Stealing:** How do employers steal in James 5:4? How do employees in Titus 2:9-10? How do we steal from God in Acts 5:2-3 and Malachi 3:8-10?
- **Coveting:** What damage does coveting cause in relationship in James 4:1-2? How should you react to the success of another person in Romans 12:15-17? What does Philippians 4:11-13 teach you about contentment?

Next Steps:
