- This year's trip dates are January 14-16, 2022 (MLK Weekend)
 - The schedule—depart Friday at noon from Calvary Church and return Sunday night between 9 to 10pm.
- Passports required. Must be valid 6 months after the trip date (July 2022).
- There is a non-refundable \$75 deposit per person to register for the trip.
- **INDIVIDUAL COST:** Per YWAM the cost of accommodations and building materials has increased slightly. The cost is \$324 per adult and \$190 per child (under 12). **These are your fees once you have paid the \$75 deposit per person**. There is a discount for families with multiple children under 18. This cost covers accommodations, team t-shirt, and all meals.
- **FUNDRAISING GOAL**: In addition, as a group we raise funds collectively for the five homes. Each home costs approximately \$9,600 to build and furnish. We plan to build a total of 5 homes. The total home amount divided by approximately 160 individuals breaks down to roughly \$300 per person to build a home.
 - Methods of fundraising can be through support letters, social media posts, garage/rummage sales, car washes, bake sales, etc.
 - Be creative, start early, and be persistent!

- Once registered for the trip our leadership team will send you information on where the funds are sent. Giving will be through an established Calvary Church website OR checks can be mailed.

 - The base accommodations are clean and safe with gates and security.
 - The build site is on dirt and mud—you will get dirty!
 - All meals are prepared by the YWAM staff. Breakfast and dinner at the base and lunches on the build site.
 - Warm showers at night. Bathrooms in each room with towels.
 - There is filtered or bottled water at the base and job site.
- The building process with YWAM is well established with materials ready to go and a foundation poured for each home ahead of our arrival.
- There will be five teams of 25 to 30 people.
 - Each team is supplied with a lead builder and assistant builder.
 - Each team has an interpreter/translator.
 - Each team has a host to guide and be a resource through the daily build process.
- This is a family mission trip. We love that the parents and kids can join serving together. It will be a wonderful experience you will never forget. Every person on the team plays an important role!
- Please prayerfully consider the trip. Arrange for time off from work and school. It is your responsibility to get signed up. Please email the leadership team at paur.calvarymexicobuild@gmail.com and we will send you registration link and next steps.
