


HUME LAKE SUMMER CAMP LETTER

June 2022

Hello High School Hume Lake Camper and Parents! This is your 'official' camp letter with all the important details about what's going to happen at Pre-Camp as well as the morning of our exciting departure to Hume Lake! Please read the entire letter!



THEME:

Truth Be Told: We live in a world where anything can be accepted as true and encourages us to define our own truth. Phrases such as “my truth,” “live your truth,” “do what’s true for you,” are used every day. These phrases force us to ask, and answer, the question, “Is there such a thing as absolute truth?” And if there is, how does that affect our life?

This summer we are going to take a look at the life of Jesus through the book of John to see how Jesus himself defines truth. Our prayer as we study the book of John together is that we would respond with love and affection for Him and have a greater priority for and deeper understanding of the truth, His word.

FINANCES:

PRE-CAMP: (Saturday, July 9, 10:00am)

To make things go quickly the morning we leave, we hold what we call 'Pre-Camp' the day before. Please meet on Saturday, July 9 at 10:00am for Pre-Camp in front of the Calvary Gym. This is when you do stuff like drop off your luggage, finalize permission forms, makes final payments, choose your bus, get a health screening, etc. The morning we leave you may bring one carry-on bag or backpack with you on the bus.

Please note: Make sure you have filled out all the medical forms for Hume and Calvary online!

LEAVING FOR HUME: (Sunday, July 10, 7:30am)

Please arrive at church in the Gym parking lot on Sunday Morning, July 10 at 7:30am SHARP! Our transportation keeps a tight schedule and will depart on time. Because we take care of most of the last minute details at Pre-Camp, Sunday morning should run smoothly. All you have to do is show up on time, check-in with us one final time and we'll load the buses and be on our way!

Please eat breakfast beforehand. We will be stopping for lunch so be sure to have your lunch money with you on the bus, not packed in your luggage. We are scheduled to arrive at Hume Lake at approximately 4:00pm.

ARRIVING HOME: (Saturday, July 16, 4:00pm)

We are scheduled to arrive back at the church between 4:00-5:00pm on Saturday, July 16. Again, save money for lunch on the way home. We will keep you posted of our ETA on Instagram [@calvaryhs](https://www.instagram.com/calvaryhs). Wi-Fi is very limited at camp, so please be patient.

What NOT to bring: (Hume is very strict on this - if you bring any of these items you will be sent home at parents' expense)

Cigarettes/Tobacco

Fireworks

Illegal drugs or Alcohol

Electronics of any kind (*cell phones can be used for photos only!*)

Weapons of any kind (*including pocket knives, wrist rockets and water balloon launchers*)

HUME DRESS CODE/MODESTY POLICY: (Please note the following updated guidelines from Hume Lake)

GIRLS:

- No 2-piece swim suits or Tankinis
- No bare midriffs
- No spaghetti straps
- No halter-tops, bare-back tops, or tube tops
- No excessively tight clothing
- Tank top straps need to be 1" or greater with no bra straps showing
- Modest shorts length - 4 inch+ inseam

GUYS:

- Shirts must be worn everywhere except at the pool and on the lake
- No visible "sagging" of pants or shorts
- No Speedos

CALVARY FOOD POLICY:

Because you need to be healthy and strong for all camp activities, it is essential that you eat at every meal! Although camp food may not be your favorite, choosing not to eat at meal times may result in you being sent home.

SPENDING MONEY & ACTIVITIES:

Suggested spending money should be anywhere from \$80-\$100. *Students are responsible for their own money + belongings!!

HUME SWIM TEST:

Hume is implementing a swim test again this year. All campers wishing to swim or be on water MUST pass this test before being given the swim wristband. Test includes; jumping into deep end feet first, swimming width of pool & back (face in the water) and treading water for 30 seconds. Retests are permitted.
