About Wild Rock camp center

Summer Camp at Wild Rock is a five-day camp specifically designed for students entering 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th grade. This is a safe place where kids will learn about their great God through age-appropriate teaching, engaging worship, and time outdoors in His Creation. It's an opportunity to meet new friends and learn about how we are designed for Christ-centered community while staying away from home for the very first time.

Wild Rock at Forest Home is a perfect match for groups looking to run an event with the great outdoors as a focus. This secluded camp center offers insulated Yurt housing with ceiling fans, USB charging, and bunk beds for up to 250 guests with community bathrooms located nearby. Five "Terrains" are comprised of three to six yurts each. Two new centralized features include a 400 sq.ft. covered portico providing shade for everyone to gather and dine, and an 18,000 sq.ft. artificial turf for games and activities. Nestled into the hillside, the Summit amphitheater offers majestic mountain views, a camp fire ring, and audio visual set up for outdoor meetings.

In addition to recreation options offered throughout Forest Home, Wild Rock truly captures the whimsy and magic of play with its camp amenities! The turf field, jumbo tire swing, tether ball, gaga ball, and a basketball hoop are all season elements available for all of your fun and creative ideas. A stay at Wild Rock is an unforgettable experience for those who want to connect with creation in a unique forest setting.

Is there a dress code for camp? What about bathing suits?

Camp is a rugged environment and you will likely get dirty one way or another—especially your shoes. In general, our expectations for camp attire are driven by modesty. In our swimming areas, we ask that all females wear one-piece bathing suits (no bikinis or tankinis) and that guys stay away from revealing briefs or speedos. We also limit swimwear to appropriate areas only and ask that you wear a coverup to and from the pool or lake.

What NOT to bring

- Fireworks
- Electronics of any kind (excluding cell phones)
- Weapons of any kind (including pocket knives, wrist rockets and water balloon launchers)
