LifeGroup Discussion:

- 1. What are some of the ways that people distort the truth of who Jesus is today? How can we graciously share with them the truth?
- 2. Practice in your group a way of sharing about Jesus from how you have experienced Him rather than just sharing facts about Him.
- 3. What has been your experience of fellowship or community within the church? How can you see that improved in your life? How can you see that grow in our church?
