



Living Among Idols Leads to Destruction Judges 2 "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh..." 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 Judges is a physical war. We are in a spiritual war. We are overcoming spiritually just like they did physically.




Living Among Idols Leads to Destruction Judges 2 • There is a cycle of sin repeated by the people of Israel that we repeat as well
