Animism: Worshipping the created instead of the Creator · Romans 1:21-25

What is Animism?

Animism is a worldview which assumes physical objects contain spiritual power which can be controlled or manipulated through rituals.

What do animists want?

- Power
- Prosperity
- Protection
- Pragmatic, not personal
- Present, not eternal

Why should we study Animism?

- We need to be better equipped to share the Gospel.
- We need to prevent animism from creeping into our faith.

Worship the Creator, not the created!

"For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing to be wise, they became fools, and exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man and of birds and four-footed animals and crawling creatures. Therefore God gave them over in the lusts of their hearts to impurity, so that their bodies would be dishonored among them. For they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen." Romans 1:21-25

Dangers of Animism

• Idolatry (Exodus 20:3, Psalm 135:15-18, Leviticus 19:4, 1 John 5:21)

How can we avoid animism creeping into our faith?

- <u>H</u>umility (v. 22)
- Recognition (v. 23)
- Obedience (v.24)
- Worship (v.25)
