Personal faith in Jesus as Savior and "Master" determines people's acceptance by God (v. 3b-4)

# A community of grace recognizes people who authentically worship Jesus Romans 14:5-9 "He who observes the day, observes it for the Lord, and he who eats, does so for the Lord..." (v. 6)

- Authentic worship is rooted in being from God and for God (v. 5-8)
- Authentic worship is rooted in the good news of Jesus Christ (v. 9)

### A community of grace points people to God's authority, not their own judgment

Romans 14:10-12

"So then each one of us will give an account of himself to God." (v. 12)

- We will all equally stand before God one day (v. 10-12)
- Jesus will be our advocate at the Judgment seat (1 John 2:1-2)

#### LifeGroup Questions:

- 1. Read Romans 14:1-4 as a group. A community of grace accepts people whom God has said are acceptable. What makes someone acceptable to God? Is a community of grace required to accept everything and anything from someone who has been accepted by God?
- 2. Read Romans 14:5-9 as a group. A community of grace recognizes people who authentically worship Jesus. What does authentic worship look like? Talk about how a style of music that isn't your preference could still be authentically worshipful.
- 3. Read Romans 14:10-12 as a group. A community of grace points people to God's authority, not their own judgment. How can our community at Calvary Church grow in this area? In what areas can you personally become more graceful towards other Christians? End your discussion by reading together out loud the corporate prayer response from this week's sermon outline.
