

## Living Free from Generation to Generation Joshua 4; Psalm 78

"For whatever was written in earlier times was written for our instruction, so that through perseverance and the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." Romans 15:4

### We are called to reveal all God's Word and Work to the next generation. Joshua 4:20-23; Psalm 78:1-8

"...When your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, 'What are these stones?' then you shall inform your children, saying, 'Israel crossed this Jordan on dry ground.' "For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the Jordan before you until you had crossed..." Joshua 4:22-23

• What we reveal: That God allows impossible challenges so we turn to Him for help (Joshua 3:1)

"Then Joshua rose early in the morning; and he and all the sons of Israel set out from Shittim and came to the Jordan"

• How we reveal: With tangible memorials because we will forget God's Word and Work (Exodus 14 - 16)

Exodus 14: Jews believe in God when He miraculously opens the Red Sea

**Exodus 15:** Jews praise God for His power to help them

**Exodus 16:** Jews grumble at God when they forget His provision for them

"Then they set out from Elim, and all the congregation of the sons of Israel came to the wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after their departure from the land of Egypt. ## LifeGroup Discussion:

- 1. We are always one generation away from wiping out our faith. Our calling is to pass on our faith in Jesus Christ to all future generations. Discuss how important it is to God that the next generations know His Word and Works.
- 2. Read Exodus 12:26-27.
  What does the Passover teach about God?
- 3. Read Deuteronomy 6:20-21. Why should you teach the next generation the "testimonies, statues and judgments" of God?
- 4. Read Psalm 71:17-18.

  At what age should the next generation begin learning about God's Word and Works?

  How long should that teaching occur?
- 5. Read Psalm 102:18-19.
  How far into the future should we have a vision for passing on our faith?
- 6. Read Psalm 78:1-8. What is our goal in passing on our faith to the next generation?
