Jesus Gifts You with an Important Role to Play in Building His Church. Ephesians 4:13-16

"from whom the whole body being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love." (v. 16)

- We are built up to be united. Ephesians 4:13
- We are grounded in what we believe. Ephesians 4:13-14
- We speak the truth in love. Ephesians 4:15
- We help restore and build up one another in love. Ephesians 4:16

LifeGroup Discussion:

- 1. Read Ephesians 4:7-10 out loud together. Jesus paid a tremendous cost to give us the gift of salvation, grace and distribute to us spiritual gifts. How does recognizing the cost Jesus paid motivate you to use the gifts He gave you?
- 2. **Read Ephesians 4:11-12 out loud together.** Jesus has given the Church the gift of leaders. What is their primary role? How can you support and encourage your leaders here at Calvary in the fulfilment of this role?
- 3. **Read Ephesians 4:13-16 out loud together.** Have you ever experienced the divide that can exist in churches where the ministry is only done by a few people? What did that feel like? According to Ephesians 4:13-16, what are some of the results of every believer using and exercising their gifts in the church? Talk through ideas of how you can use your God-given gifts to build up Calvary Church. Be specific, create an action plan, and hold one another accountable!
