- 3 key questions in this story
 - What must I do to inherit eternal life? (Luke 10:25)
 - Who is my neighbor? (Luke 10:29)
 - Which of these three do you think proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell into the robber's hands? (Luke 10:36)

Digging Deeper and LifeGroup Discussion:

There are 3 key questions raised in the story of the Good Samaritan in Luke 10:25-37

1. In verse 25, The lawyer asks, *"What must I do to inherit eternal life?"* If a friend or a family member were to ask you this same question today how would you answer them? What passages in the Bible would you share with them to support your answer?
2. In verse 29, the lawyer again asks a question of Jesus, *"...and who is my neighbor?"* Using the parable of the "Good Samaritan", how would you answer this question?
3. In verse 36, Jesus asks the question, *"Which of these three do you think proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell into the robber's hands?"* The lawyer reluctantly answers in verse 37, *"the one who showed mercy on him."* Jesus then tells the lawyer to *"go and do the same."* What would it practically look like for you in our modern world and in this unique moment in history to "go and do the same?" What holds you back from going and doing the same?
