

### The Road to Real Rest Hebrews 3:7-19

### **Learn from the past** Hebrews 3:7-11

Hebrews 3:8 – "Do not harden your hearts as when they provoked Me, as in the day of trial in the wilderness."

- This verse quotes Psalm 95:7-11 that refers to Exodus 17:1-17 and Numbers 20:1-13 while also the greater sins of Numbers 13-14.
- Numbers 14:20 pardoned but punished. Eternal vs. Temporal.
- Response: Commit to reading scripture to learn from biblical past and commit to spending some time in reflection on your own past to learn from those experiences.

### **Encourage faithfulness in one another** Hebrews 3:12-15

Hebrews 3:13 – "But encourage one another day after day...so that none of you will be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin."

- We need to look out for each other. We need to notice when a brother or sister is struggling.
- Encouragement is the antidote to the deceitfulness of sin.
- Response: Choose one person who you will encourage this week and do it!

#### We can't have rest without obedience Hebrews 3:16-19

Hebrews 3:18 – "And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who were disobedient?"

- Lack of belief is what kept the Israelites out of the Promised Land. Their unbelief led them to disobedience.
- Three types of rest
  - o Canaan rest Cease struggling with the enemy and trust in the power of God.
  - Creation rest Trust in the completed work of God like the rest after six days of creation. Trust the finished work of Messiah and don't return to the Law. This is redemptive rest.
  - Sabbath rest The spiritual rest of spiritual maturity.
- Response: In prayer, ask God to reveal any areas of unbelief or disobedience that are preventing you from entering true rest.



# Preparation

If possible, find a quiet and comfortable place. Rid yourself of distractions such as your phone, television, school work, interruptions from others, etc. Open yourself to God and intend to learn from Him. "Lord, here I am, I present myself to You. Open my heart to the truth of what is going on in my life."

## 2 Read the Text: Hebrews 3:7-19

Read the text a few times until you have a clear understanding of what the passage is saying.

# Contemplate + Journal

Spend time thinking about and journaling your thoughts to the following questions. If you meet with a LifeGroup, you can also share your responses with them and have a great discussion.

- What is a word or phrase the Lord impressed on you in this time? Meditate on that.
- Hebrews 3:9 speaks to God's faithfulness to His people as they were in the wilderness. Can you recall seasons of your life when you felt as if you were "in the wilderness?" Consider how God was faithful in these seasons.
- What does it mean to "enter into God's rest?"
- What does it look like for you to find rest in this particular season?
- How and what do you feel right now? Is there a specific situation in your life today that relates to this passage today? Pray through this for a moment.

## Praise + Worship

Worship is an act or mindset shift that realigns us to the reality of who God is. Find this song on Spotify, YouTube, AppleMusic, etc. and the lyrics if you would like to read or sing along. Make this song your prayer and declaration of praise and worship as you hear truths being sung over you. Allow the Lord to minister to your heart in this time.

Song Recommendation: "Rest In You" by All Sons & Daughters

## **6** Closing Prayer

Spend some time in prayer. Whether it is simply sitting in God's loving presence, expressing thankfulness and gratitude, and/or offering up supplication, pray what is on your heart at this time.

May you find true rest as you take Jesus' easy yoke upon you, knowing that His yoke is easy and His burden is light. May you experience His peace as you find rest in Him. Scripture Reference: Matthew 11:28-30
