

### **Hold Fast to Jesus** Hebrews 4:14-16

Jesus is supreme, sees all we do and we must give an account to Him. Hebrews 4:13

We are to hold fast to Jesus because...

Jesus is our high priest, the Son of God, that rules from the highest power. Hebrews 4:14

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God let us <u>hold fast our confession</u>.

Hebrews 3:1,6 • Hebrews 10:23

#### Jesus is our high priest, qualified to sympathize with us in our lowest weakness. Hebrews 4:15

"For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin."

- Qualified because He suffered and was tempted, and is able to help us when we are tempted. Hebrews 2:18
  - Weakness =
    - Our physical weaknesses. Matthew 26:41
    - Our spiritual weaknesses. Romans 5:6; Galatians 4:9
    - Our moral weaknesses. 1 Corinthians 8:7
  - **Sympathy**: sun = with, pascho = suffer. Jesus will suffer with us compassionately. Hebrews 12:1-3
- Qualified because He overcame every temptation without sin.

#### Therefore, draw near to Jesus. Hebrews 4:16, 7:25

Hebrews 4:16 – "Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

- Draw near with confidence to His throne of grace.
  - **Confidence** = "all speech" we can speak boldly to Jesus without fear.
- Draw near and receive mercy and grace to help in your time of need.



# Preparation

If possible, find a quiet and comfortable place. Rid yourself of distractions such as your phone, television, school work, interruptions from others, etc. Open yourself to God and intend to learn from Him.

"Lord, here I am, I present myself to You. Open my heart to the truth of what is going on in my life."

### 2 Read the Text: Hebrews 4:14-16 & Psalm 100:2-4

Read the text a few times until you have a clear understanding of what the passage is saying.

### 3 Contemplate + Journal

Spend time thinking about and journaling your thoughts to the following questions after meditating on each of the scriptures above. If you meet with a LifeGroup, you can also share your responses and discuss together.

- Truly, we can draw near to God in worship. According to Psalm 100:2-4, what does it look like to approach God? How does He view us as we approach Him? What does this mean for you and your relationship with Him?
- How does it feel knowing that Jesus understands our weaknesses? How does this comfort you specifically? Open up to the Lord about this.
- How and what do you feel? Is there a situation in your life that relates to this passage? Pray through this.

## 4 Praise + Worship

Worship is an act or mindset shift that realigns us to the reality of who God is. Find this song on Spotify, YouTube, AppleMusic, etc. and the lyrics if you would like to read or sing along. Make this song your prayer and declaration of praise and worship as you hear truths being sung over you. Allow the Lord to minister to your heart in this time.
