"For the whole Law is fulfilled in one word, in the statement, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

- In my growing up years at Calvary (Jon), during the week, I was in the game, but in a different game
- Part of being a good neighbor is being open and real
- Some ups and downs of being a missionary neighbor
 - Jeremiah 20: 7-18 "I have become a laughingstock all day long; Everyone mocks me... But the Lord is with me like a (mighty) dread warrior..."

Don't Give Up When Loving Your Neighbors Gets Difficult Galatians 6:9

"Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary."

- Do not lose heart when reality doesn't meet expectations
- God's clock is always on schedule
- Reaping a harvest
 - Luke 10:2 "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

Preparation

If possible, find a quiet and comfortable place. Rid yourself of distractions such as your phone, television, school work, interruptions from others, etc. Open yourself to God and intend to learn from Him. "Lord, here I am, I present myself to You. Open my heart to the truth of what is going on in my life."

2 Read the Text: Galatians 5:14, 6:9 • Colossians 4:2

Read the text a few times until you have a clear understanding of what the passage is saying.

Ontemplate + Journal

Spend time thinking about and journaling your thoughts to the following questions. If you meet with a LifeGroup, you can also share your responses with them and have a great discussion.

- Ask the Lord, "Lord, why do You place such an importance in the scriptures on loving our neighbors?"
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, what does it practically look like for me to live the Galatians 5:14 call to 'love your neighbor as yourself?"
- Galatians 6:9 encourages us to "not lose heart in doing good." Ask the Lord, "Lord, in what ways does my heart need encouragement as I consider loving my neighbor?"
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, as I engage with You in prayer, how can prayer serve as a catalyst to love my neighbors?"

Praise + Worship

Worship is an act or mindset shift that realigns us to the reality of who God is. Find this song on Spotify, YouTube, AppleMusic, etc. and the lyrics if you would like to read or sing along. Make this song your prayer and declaration of praise and worship as you hear truths being sung over you. Allow the Lord to minister to your heart in this time. Song Recommendation: "God of this City" by Chris Tomlin

5 Closing Prayer

Spend some time in prayer. Whether it is simply sitting in God's loving presence, expressing thankfulness and gratitude, and/or offering up supplication, pray what is on your heart in this time.

6 Blessing

May you know that you can be strong and have courage because our God will go with you and He will not leave you or forsake you **Deuteronomy 31:6**
