



FAITH DURING FEAR HEBREWS 11:1-7

What is faith? Hebrews 11:1-3

Hebrews 11:1 - "Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."

- <u>Assurance</u> = Υπόστασις hupostasis = essence, nature, assurance. This is the word used in ancient documents to guarantee ownership or title. Hebrews 1:3 Jesus is "the exact representation of His nature."
- <u>Conviction</u> = ἕλεγχος ellegmos = rebuke, reproof, convict. Also used in 2 Timothy 3:16 "All scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness."
- Faith is a gift from God, not an action of our will. Faith is about God's power and promises not our determination.
- History proves it is possible to live by faith and God approves of us because of the faith that He has empowered us to display. Hebrews 11:2
- We have faith in God for the future and we have faith to believe in how God has worked in the past. Hebrews 11:3

Faith worth following Hebrews 11:4-7

- Abel Genesis 4:1-16 an example of worshiping in faith
 - Abel's heart was right before God and his trust in God reflected that
 - Faith doesn't mean everything will go your way. Abel was murdered by his brother.
- Enoch Genesis 5:22-24 an example of walking in faith
 - Enoch had faith that God exists and he sought after God.
 - Enoch "walked with God" which shows dependence and intimacy.
- Noah Genesis 6-9 an example of obeying in faith
 - Noah obeyed even while being mocked. He trusted the word of God, not his own efforts or the opinion of others.
 - Noah wasn't perfect. He committed egregious sins. God's faithfulness covers our sins.

Response:

- Look to the faithfulness of God in the lives of these Old Testament heroes to bolster your faith in times of doubt, fear, and suffering.

DIGGING DEEPER

HEBREWS 11:1-7

O Preparation

If possible, find a quiet and comfortable place. Rid yourself of distractions such as your phone, television, school work, interruptions from others, etc. Open yourself to God and intend to learn from Him. "Lord, here I am, I present myself to You. Open my heart to the truth of what is going on in my life."

2 Read the Text: Hebrews 11:1-7 & 2 Corinthians 5:7

Read the text a few times until you have a clear understanding of what the passage is saying.

3 Contemplate + Journal

Spend time thinking about and journaling your thoughts to the following questions. If you meet with a LifeGroup, you can also share your responses with them and have a great discussion.

- What is a word or phrase the Lord impressed on you in this time? Meditate on that.
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, what are some seasons of my life, moments, or events that have deepened my faith in You? Tell me about them."
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, what would it look like for me to live by faith and not by sight? What are You inviting me into here?"
- How and what do you feel? Is there a specific situation in your life that relates to this passage today? Pray through this for a moment.

Praise + Worship

Worship is an act or mindset shift that realigns us to the reality of who God is. Find this song on Spotify, YouTube, AppleMusic, etc. and the lyrics if you would like to read or sing along. Make this song your prayer and declaration of praise and worship as you hear truths being sung over you. Allow the Lord to minister to your heart in this time. **Song Recommendation:** "<u>Give Me Faith</u>" By Elevation Worship

6 Closing Prayer

Spend some time in prayer. Whether it is simply sitting in God's loving presence, expressing thankfulness and gratitude, and/or offering up supplication, pray what is on your heart in this time.

6 Blessing

May the Lord deepen your faith as you learn to trust in Him, abide in Him, walk with Him, and obey Him in all you do.
