COMPASSION

Compassion Needed Isaiah 49:15

What is compassion?

- Exodus 34:6 "The Lord passed by in front of him and proclaimed, 'The Lord, The Lord God, **compassionate** and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth."
- Rakhum Hebrew for compassion, deeply moved. Rekhem Hebrew for womb.
 - Isaiah 49:15 "Can a woman forget her nursing child, and have no **compassion** on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, but I will not forget you."
- Oiktirmos Greek for compassion, pity, mercy.
 - 2 Corinthians 1:3 God is the "Father of compassion."
- The Latin roots of compassion are to "suffer with" or "suffer together."
- Immanuel God with us.
- The birth of Christ and His incarnation are the ultimate display of God's compassion.

Why do we need compassion?

- "Long lay the world, in sin and error pining" O Holy Night
- Psalm 51:1 "Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great **compassion** blot out my transgressions."
- Romans 5:8 "while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
- Isaiah 30:18 (NIV) "Yet the Lord longs to be gracious to you; therefore he will rise up to show you compassion."

An opportunity to live out God's compassion

- Mark 6:34 "When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had **compassion** on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd."
- Mark 1:41 "Moved with **compassion**, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him (the leper) and said to him, 'I am willing, be cleansed."
- We have an opportunity to sponsor 250 children in extreme poverty in a similar region in Guatemala and tangibly display the compassion of God and the gospel itself. You can find more information and choose a child to sponsor at calvarylife.org/compassion

Communion: We will give thanks and remember God's "suffering with" us as Immanuel through participating in the Lord's Supper together after the sermon.

DIGGING DEEPER

Isaiah 49:15

O Preparation

If possible, find a quiet and comfortable place. Rid yourself of distractions such as your phone, television, school work, interruptions from others, etc. Open yourself to God and intend to learn from Him. <u>"Lord, here I am, I present myself to</u> <u>You. Open my heart to the truth of what is going on in my life."</u>

2 Read the Text: Isaiah 49:15

Read the text a few times until you have a clear understanding of what the passage is saying.

Contemplate + Journal

Spend time thinking about and journaling your thoughts to the following questions. If you meet with a LifeGroup, you can also share your responses with them and have a great discussion.

- What is a word or phrase the Lord impressed on you in this time? Meditate on that.
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, how have I experienced compassion from you in my life? Are there particular seasons where I felt your compassion more intently?"
- Ask the Lord, "Lord, where are you inviting me to open my heart to you, to let you love me, and experience your great compassion? And, Lord, what would it look like to rest in your compassion today?"
- How and what do you feel? Is there a specific situation in your life that relates to this passage today? Pray through this for a moment.

Praise + Worship

Worship is an act or mindset shift that realigns us to the reality of who God is. Find this song on Spotify, YouTube, AppleMusic, etc. and the lyrics if you would like to read or sing along. Make this song your prayer and declaration of praise and worship as you hear truths being sung over you. Allow the Lord to minister to your heart in this time. **Song Recommendation:** "Lord I Need You" by Matt Maher

6 Closing Prayer

Spend some time in prayer. Whether it is simply sitting in God's loving presence, expressing thankfulness and gratitude, and/or offering up supplication, pray what is on your heart.

May you experience the great compassion that our Lord Jesus Christ has for you as you open to His amazing grace and mercy for you.


