

BE READY 2 TIMOTHY 4:6-8

2 Timothy 4:2 "be ready in season and out of season" teaching the Word and serving the Lord.

<u>Ready</u> =SUNAGŌ to assemble (sun - together / agō - to bring)
This word is used to refer to the gathering together of people or things.

Make sure you are still ready....

Ready for the time of our departure 2 Timothy 4:6

"For I am already (now ready) being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come." 2 Timothy 4:6

Psalm 116:15

Ready because we are finishing well 2 Timothy 4:7

"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the course, I have kept the faith" 2 Timothy 4:7

- "Fought" = to contend in the games against opposition and persecution.
- "Good" = a "good" servant nourished in biblical teaching. 1 Timothy 4:6 = perform "good" deeds that are profitable. Titus 3:14

Ready for the Lord, the righteous judge 2 Timothy 4:8

"...in the future there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day; and not only to me, but also to all who have loved His appearing." 2 Timothy 4:8

Matthew 13:41–42 "The Son of Man will send forth His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, and those who commit lawlessness, and will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

Matthew 16:27 "For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and WILL THEN REPAY EVERY MAN ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS."

Matthew 24:44 "For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think He will."
