

Victory in Your Spiritual Battles Galatians 5:16-21

We must acknowledge the spiritual battle we are in. Galatians 5:16-17

^{*}But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please."

- The desires of your flesh are in opposition to the desires of the Holy Spirit so you do not do what is right. Romans 7:18-20
 - Your flesh is born in sin. Psalm 51:5
 - Your flesh will grow in sin. Titus 3:3
- You can experience a new spiritual birth by the Spirit so He will give you victory over your flesh. Galatians 5:16, 18 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh...But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law.

Galatians is now addressing some of the deep needs of any Christian's life by exposing the desires and deeds of our sinful flesh and its opposition to the Holy Spirit. While the battle can be difficult, we have great power "walking by the Spirit" and being "led by the Spirit" to overcome the areas of attack as Paul listed them in Galatians 5:19-21. Each of those areas will be replaced by the "fruit of the Spirit" found in Galatians 5:22-24 if we are led by the Spirit.

LifeGroup Discussion

Privately, read through the list of fleshly sins in Galatians 5:19-21. Do you recognize any of these areas as battle lines in your life? Are you being tempted in any of these areas and struggling to overcome them?

The following steps can help you "walk by the Spirit" and be "led by the Spirit" to overcome all sin. Look up each passage and discuss what it means and how it can help you overcome the opposition to your flesh.

- Confess any sin that may grieve or quench the Holy Spirit's work in your life. Ephesians 4:30 · 1 Thessalonians 5:19 How do you feel when another offends or hurts you to cause grief in your life? Does that help you understand the idea of grieving the Holy Spirit?
- Read, reflect and apply the Bible. Colossians 3:16 · 2 Timothy 3:15-17
 What happens when the Word of Christ dwells in you?
 How are the Scriptures profitable and what will they do for you as you learn them?
- 3. Grow intimate with and learn about Jesus. Romans 13:14 · Hebrews 12:1-3 · 2 Peter 1:2-4 In Hebrews 12:1-3, what do you need to lay aside? What should you focus on instead?
- 4. Faithfully connect with the community of Christ for encouragement and accountability. Hebrews 10:23-25 Community with Christians is important. How will they help your spiritual growth in Hebrews 10:23-25?
