3 Questions We Still Ask Today Mark 4:35-41

Does Jesus care?

Mark 4:38b – *“Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?”*

Why am I afraid?

Mark 4:40a – *“And He said to them, ‘Why are you afraid?’”*

Do I have faith?

Mark 4:40b – *“Do you still have no faith?”*

RESPONSE

Write a letter of trust to God about how you respond to these questions. Let it be your prayer.

Digging Deeper + LifeGroup Discussion:

1. How have you processed the question, “Does Jesus care?” in your life? Do you currently struggle with this and how? Have members of the group speak of their experience with this question.
2. How much is fear part of your life? Do you feel like Jesus would call you cowardly like He did the disciples in this story? Remember that the disciples went on to do great things through the Holy Spirit’s power so don’t think that this disqualifies you for ministry.
3. How do you evaluate your own level of faith? Jesus questioned the disciples’ faith. How can we encourage and increase one another’s faith?
