You Give Them Something to Eat Mark 6:31-44

Jesus has compassion for people. Mark 6:31-34

Mark 6:34 - "...and He felt compassion for them because they were like sheep without a shepherd..."

We should come to Jesus with questions before suggestions. Mark 6:35-36

Mark 6:35-36 – "...His disciples came to Him and said, 'This place is desolate and it is already quite late; send them away so that they may go... buy themselves something to eat."

We can't outsource servanthood to God or others. Mark 6:37

Mark 6:37a - "But He answered them, 'You give them something to eat!""

What do you have to offer? Mark 6:38

Mark 6:38 - "And He said to them, 'How many loaves do you have? Go look!""

Jesus satisfies our ultimate needs. Mark 6:39-44

Mark 6:42 – "They all ate and were satisfied."

Response: Fill out the card entitled "How many loaves do you have?" Jesus commanded them to "Go look" and see what they already had to contribute. What do you have that can be available for God to use when needed?

Digging Deeper + LifeGroup Discussion:

- 1. Discuss how you have come to Jesus with suggestions rather than questions or requests. We see the disciples do that in Mark 6:35-36 and Jesus turns it back on them. How should our posture shift in how we approach God with things?
- 2. Do you ever think "What is the church going to do about _____?" Remember that *you* are the church. Is this a tendency that you fall into easily?
- 3. Jesus asked the disciples, "How many loaves do you have?" Talk about how you can combine forces as a LifeGroup to help others with significant needs. What resources do you have together and how can you use them for furthering God's kingdom?
