

The Testing of our Faith Mark 6:45-52

Jesus will put us in situations to test our faith. Mark 6:45-48

"Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side to Bethsaida, while He Himself was sending the crowd away. After bidding them farewell, He left for the mountain to pray.... Seeing them straining at the oars, for the wind was against them"

"made" =

"strain" =

- We will feel alone
- We will initially "strain" to move through the experience

2 Chronicles 33:10-13

Jesus will be watching, waiting and working to be with us. Mark 6:48-49

"...at about the fourth watch [3:00 - 6:00 AM] of the night He came to them, walking on the sea; and He intended to pass by them. But when they saw Him walking on the sea, they supposed that it was a ghost, and cried out"

"pass by" =

Exodus 33:22 and 34:6; Genesis 16:13; Psalm 139:1-6, 15-17

Jesus offers words for courage and will be present to help Mark 6:49-51

"But when they saw Him walking on the sea, they supposed that it was a ghost, and cried out; for they all saw Him and were terrified. But immediately He spoke with them and said to them, 'Take courage; it is I, do not be afraid.' Then He got into the boat with them, and the wind stopped; and they were utterly astonished"

Isaiah 41:4, 10, 13-14; 43:1, 2; 44:8; Acts 23:10-12; John 16:33

Warning: Our emotional fears may undermine our faith in Jesus' words and presence.

- Fear comes when it seems that Jesus has left me alone. Vs. 46
- Fear comes when I "strain" alone in my own strength. Vs. 48
- Fear may distort my view of Jesus. Vs. 49
- Fear can harden my heart of Jesus' work in my life. Vs. 52
- Faith grows as I listen and learn from the Words of Jesus. Vs. 50
- Faith expects Jesus to be present and help me. Vs. 51
- Faith discovers a new reality of the presence of Jesus as one who cares for me. Vs. 51

Therefore, remember and reflect on Jesus' past help for you and His present Word for you. Mark 6:52 "for they had not gained any insight from the incident of the loaves, but their heart was hardened."

for they had not gamed any maight from the modern of the loaves, but then heart was hard
