SOMETIMES STORMS COME (Acts 27:13-26)

- Storms can cause us to lose hope (v.20)

What are some of the storms you have weathered in life?

- Paul encourages others to have courage (v.22; 25)

LOOKING FOR ANCHORS IN THE STORM (Acts 27:27-38)

- Jesus wants us to trust Him to be our anchor in the storm (v.29)

What things do you put trust in as your anchor?

- Storms can change our direction and leave us shipwrecked, without hope, trying to escape (v.30)

Shipwrecked VBS Daily Themes:

- When you're lonely...Jesus rescues!
- When you worry...Jesus rescues!
- When you struggle...Jesus rescues!
- When you do wrong...Jesus rescues!
- When you're powerless...Jesus rescues!

JESUS RESCUES (Acts 27:39-44)

- Our own rescue attempts fail (v.40-41)

When are times you feel alone, hopeless, and shipwrecked?

- Jesus rescues us from something greater than our situations - He rescues us from our sin.

"Jesus gave His life for our sins, just as God our Father planned, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live." Galatians 1:4 (NLT)
